Remove the broken slate



Position Hallhook™ between slates so that bottom hook slate baseline and fix with is 10mm above finished nail. Hang hook pull on Hallhook



hooks the base of the slate Slide new slate into place Then gently pull the hook pull until the Hallhook™ Do not over stretch Remove hook pull.

## W IT WORKS



- 1. Fits between slates. Once nail fixing is applied at 2. This provides a vertical line to 3. Prevents lateral movement.
- 2. Two nail fixings are offered. The nail fixing to be used is dependent on size of slate head lap.
- 3. Upward biased spring that remains in contact underneath. The underside contact prevents whilst disappearing between the two slates with the underside of the object slate the hook pull slipping off the Hallhook™
